Paul F. Pimentel, LT:

Paul F. Pimentel, 76, died in Los Angeles, CA on February 5, 2019. Paul served aboard the Berkeley as a LT from 1965 to 1968.

After serving as deputy secretary of the state of Massachusetts, Paul turned to the environment, energy independence, and the economy. During the course of

40 years, he and his team brought their vision from startup to a world leader in the industry. They developed a model that unlocked billions of dollars in energy and water savings, and is now being implemented across the globe. Paul was most proud of the creation of Vineyard Power, an independent, clean-energy cooperative that will bring more than 800 megawatts of low-cost offshore wind power to the Cape and Islands of Massachusetts.

Paul is survived by his wife Sandra; his children, Lisa Pimentel, Christopher Pimentel, Susan Andrien, Courtney Child, and Joanie Pimentel; nine grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; several foster children; and a bounty of extended family and friends.

Michael G. Merchant, CDR:

Michael served aboard the Berkeley from 1970 to 1972, and was the Weapons Officer. Michael died on February 27, 2019.

Wayne N. Stoker, OSC:

Wayne served aboard the Berkeley as a Chief from 1970 to 1974. Wayne died on March 13, 2019.

Berkeley's Gunfire Support

If anyone is interested in reviewing the USS Berkeley's Naval Gunfire Support history during the Vietnam War (March 1966 – January 1973), it can be found by going to www.aad.archives.gov.

Once you enter the site, select Vietnam War 1965 – 1975. That will take you to "Wars/International Relations: Vietnam War. Scroll down the page to "Records About Naval Gunfire Support During The Vietnam War, created 3/1966 – 3/1973" Select the second search button, and click on it. In the boxes, fill in the following: Name of Firing Ship – Berkeley; Hull Type of Firing Ship – click on the "Select from Code List", and select DDG and click on submit; Hull Number of Firing Ship – 15; then click on "search.

You will be provided with 830 partial records. To view each individual record, click on the "View Record" in the first column.

Note: Are the values in the field "Range To Target in Thousands of Yards" accurate? When NARA staff reviewed the records, they found that a significant number of the values provided distances beyond the accurate range of typical gunfire.
